2019 STUDENT ENROLMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Membership to the AFT is compulsory for all students.
- The class calendar is subject to a minimum enrolment of eight (8) students per class.
- Each term consists of eight (8) weeks.
- Classes are subject to variation due to enrolment numbers and days may be changed at the discretion of the AFT.
- The AFT reserves the right to cancel courses if minimum enrolments are not received.
- If a class is cancelled by the AFT, students will be notified and arrangements for rescheduling the class will be made in consultation between teacher and class members.
- Enrolment is confirmed when payment is made, in full, prior to the first lesson.
- Pro-rata payment is not available.
- Except in circumstances in which the AFT Committee must make the decision to cancel a class, no refund will be provided to students who miss classes or decide to discontinue once payment has been received. Classes are organised in advance to ensure teacher availability and are based on student enrolments. Students dropping out of classes after commencement would make the class unviable and disadvantage those remaining for the entirety of the term. Furthermore, we do not have the administrative capacity, nor are we able to cover the high costs associated with refunds. As we are unsure when classes are scheduled in future terms, we cannot provide credit towards classes.
- To ensure the best quality in teaching the AFT reserves the right to redirect a student to another class level if the student's level does not match the other members of the class.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

The AFT follows the standards set by the Council of Europe to define its classes. The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (created by the Council of Europe) is the most widely accepted international reference for teaching and learning European languages and for the assessment of language proficiency. Referred to as the CEFR (or CECR in French) it sets clear standards to be attained at successive stages of learning and for evaluating outcomes in an internationally comparable manner. Basic French BF.1:	<p>Description: This course is perfect for first time learners, enthusiastic beginners or to prepare for a trip overseas! It is offered as a standalone two-term unit introducing students to the very basics of French. 'Basic French BF.1' is the first term of the two-term unit. In term two students continue from where they finished in term one with 'Basic French BF.2'.</p> <p>Textbook: BBC French Active-Talk (available for purchase from the AFT).</p>
Basic French BF.2:	<p>Description: The second of a standalone two-term unit introducing students to the very basics of French. 'Basic French BF.2' follows on from where 'Basic French BF.1' finished in term 1.</p> <p>Textbook: BBC French Active-Talk (available for purchase from the AFT).</p>
A1.1:	<p>Description: This course follows on from one year of study with the AFT, that is, one or two terms of Basic French followed by two or three terms of A1.1 or equivalent prior knowledge. This course begins with <i>Alter Ego Plus 1 A1</i> starting at dossier 3.</p> <p>Textbook: <i>Alter Ego Plus 1 A1</i> (available for purchase from the AFT).</p>
A2.1:	<p>Description: This course is for students studying at the Elementary A2 level. After completing <i>Alter Ego Plus 1 A1</i> in 2018 students move on to the new textbooks <i>Alter Ego Plus 2 A2</i> starting at dossier 0.</p> <p>Textbook: <i>Alter Ego Plus 2 A2</i> (available for purchase from the AFT).</p>
B1.1	<p>Description: This course is for students studying at the Intermediate B1 level. Students will continue with <i>Alter Ego Plus 3 B1</i> resuming at dossier 4.</p> <p>Textbook: <i>Alter Ego Plus 3 B1</i> (available for purchase from the AFT).</p>
